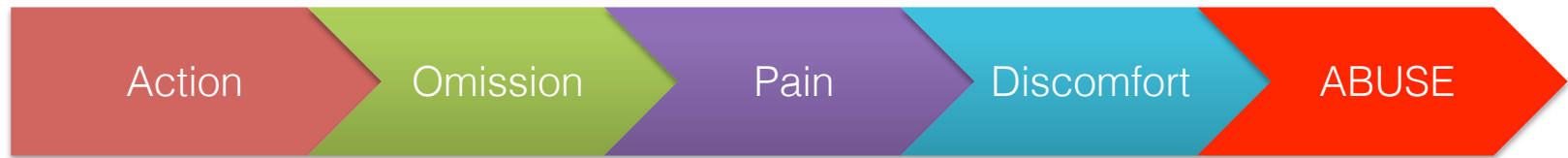

# Stewarding – what is it?

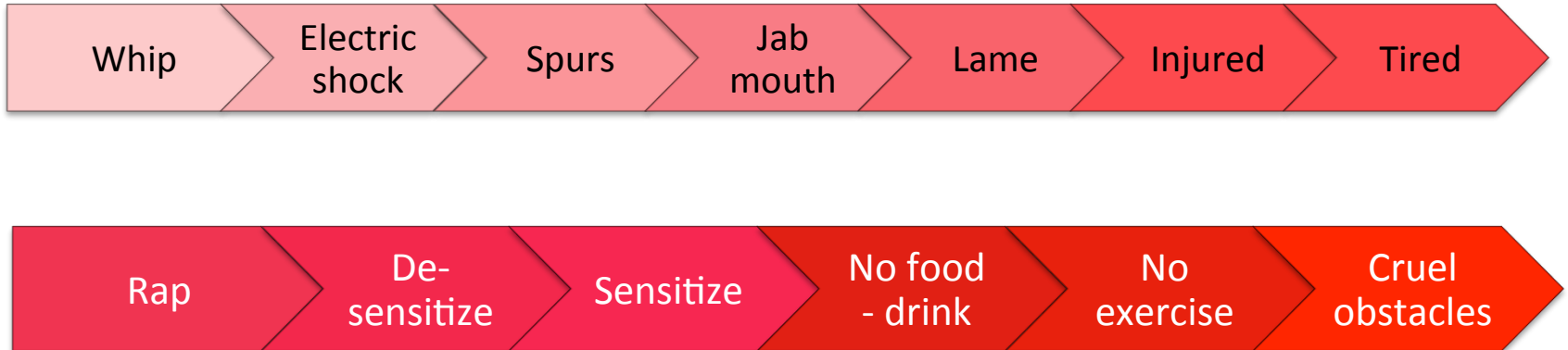
Supervision by trained individuals to ensure

# Stewarding at Jumping CIs Requirements

- Chief Steward (Level 2 or Level 3)
- Appropriate number of Stewards (min L1) in team
  - Minimum 4 stewards if 1 competition arena
- Complete freedom of access to restricted areas
- They control entire restricted area and all schooling areas



# The Chief Steward

- Reports to PGJ any contravention of rules/regulations relating to CS' responsibilities
- Informs PGJ, Appeal Committee and TD of any infractions meriting Yellow Warning Card and additional action
- May issue Yellow Warning Cards
