I have decided to run for President of the IJOC because after the years that have passed and the achievements made, it is time to face and reflect on the changes that have taken place during our activity as Officials.

Counting on your trust, the points on which the line of action of the Club would focus on during the next term 2019-2021 would be the following:

EFFECTIVENESS OF THE MOU SIGNED WITH THE FEI

The signing was an important milestone in the life of the Club, but many believe that its operation has not reached the expected levels, without participating in areas where we should have done (as was the case with the Working Group on Officials). I think we should get the Club - as a Club - to be heard and consulted on what affects us.

REDESIGN OF LEVELS AND PROMOTIONS

The promotion policy of the FEI has been pending to develop for some time and we must try to follow a line that prioritizes the merits instead of the requirements, since it is the merits that are achieved through the day-to-day of our actions and should be the main factor for the promotion.

CLARITY IN THE APPOINTMENTES AS FOREIGN JUDGE AND FOREIGN STEWARD

There is no policy or criteria for these appointments: Officials without experience are sent to important competitions while other Officials with proven experience are sent to competitions of a lower level, which in both cases is negative. In the future we should try to achieve clarity, explicit criteria and publicity.

ROTATION IN COMPETITIONS

We must try to propose a formula that incorporates a wider group of Judges and Other Officials to the most important shows and Tours (Global, World Cup, Nations Cup, ...)

FEES AND EXPENSES

In our sport, the economic cost is greater each time for everyone ... except for the Officials. We must try to achieve conditions that take into account the complexity of our functions, the difficult conditions in which they are developed, long working hours and our ever-increasing responsibility. Some of the revision points on which we should try to act would be:

- 1. Updating the per diem to levels appropriate according to the reality of the competition.*
- 2. Improvement - where appropriate - of the category and location of the accommodation.*
- 3. Rationality in the selection of means of transport, as well as in their schedules.*
- 4. Increase in the minimum diet, also more in line with reality.*
- 5. Compliance with the number of Officials required by the FEI in the competitions where it is not currently applicable.*

And above all, as an unrenounceable objective ...

EXPANSION OF OUR CLUB

We must recover those former members not affiliated today and incorporate new colleagues, especially from countries where our implantation - for various reasons - has been less so far. All this adding a value to the fee that is motivating for these affiliations.
