> 1. Welcome and opening by President and approval of the minutes WL WL welcomed the participants. The members shared information about the COVID situation in his country. The minutes from the last board meeting were approved with one remark from SAQ.

2. Financial Report

3. Organization of election 2021

AK presented to the board the progress of the organization of the online GA and elections/voting/approval.

Elections/voting/approval were discussed at two directions – board members elections, which we do online since years and elections/voting during the GA, such as scrutineers and approval of the documents (budget, reports, etc.).



He presented an offer from professional company Lumi – services provider of FEI and EEG GAs. AK made short summary of the options which the company could provide.

Every member gave his opinion and after a discussion the board anonymously agreed that the offer is very expensive. The scale of the club does not allow to spend sum of approx. 7900 GBP and this money should be for activities for our members.

The aboard agreed they with own efforts we can organize the GA with Zoom or another platform.

For the board election IJOC will use the existing system and the elections will go only online.

AK and LVDG will check some other companies for professional technical assistance and a person which will be moderator.

4. Organization of online seminar January 2021 TS/WL WL and TS presented to the board the result from their meeting with Frances Triutzi, Frank Spadinger and Stephan Ellenbruch. At the meeting was discussed the organization of online educational seminar:

TS presented an idea and concept IJOC to organize an in-person maintenance course for course designer during the European Championships 2021.

He presented the pros and cons and the board agreed that the idea is good and if the Championships would be approved by FEI than IJOC should work on it.
