Re. PCR testing expenses for FEI Officials

Dear Eric,

Further to your letter of 9 September 2021 seeking clarification regarding PCR testing expenses for FEI Officials, please find hereinafter the FEI's position.

While the FEI Rules are silent on the specific topic of responsibility for the costs of the PCR/Covid tests for FEI Officials, it is the FEI's position that if the travel expenses of the FEI Officials are being covered by the OC, then the OC should also cover the costs of the PCR/Covid tests of said FEI Officials if the test is a pre-requisite for entry into the country of the event and/or re-entry into the FEI Official's country of residence as such tests would clearly be "travel related expenses" that the FEI Officials would not have incurred if they had not been requested to travel to the OC's event.
