Main Goals 2022



- 1. Establish an FEI WG to address the challenges Officials face. For example:
 - Evaluation of working conditions the number of horses in relation to the number of the officials, the length of the work days

 - To explore the problems / needs of the region

- Promote and host online meetings to discuss future rule change proposals and again after distribution by the FEI of the first drafts
